Students may take all specialized courses at the cooperating college. Related technical and general education courses required in the program may be taken either at Richland or at the cooperating college. The cooperating college issues all degrees or certificates for successful completion of the program. Additional information is available from the Director of Admissions at the college offering the program. **When applying for a Cooperative Agreement, students must provide a copy of the Program Sheet from the college to which they are applying. When applying for continued enrollment, students must submit grade reports for previously approved semesters.**
